Hi Suzanne,

The Development inspectors have deemed your property as existing non-conforming which means it was constructed as it currently sits prior to the implementation of the bylaw in 1970. As discussed, no construction or alterations have occurred in the last 50 years since the original building permit. A new building permit and compliance with the new building code are not required for an existing legally constructed building. Please ensure a Building Permit is obtained prior to commencing any future upgrades/modifications to the building.

Division C

2.2.10.9. Responsibility for Compliance

- 1) Neither the issuance of a *permit* nor inspections made by the *authority having jurisdiction* shall in any way relieve the *owner* of a *building* from full responsibility for carrying out the construction or having the construction carried out in accordance with the requirements of the Safety Codes Act and its Regulations, this Code, or the *permit*, including compliance with any special conditions required by the *authority* having jurisdiction.
- 2) The owner shall ensure that all activities that take place on the site meet the requirements of this Code.
